Texas Partners provide resources to purchase Bibles, activities, Sunday School material, food, clothing, building materials and much more. These directly impact the people of Burgos.

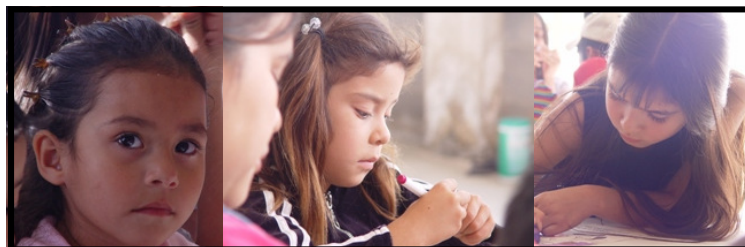


Sunday School provides Christian Education for the children of the church. Teachers are also being trained and given opportunity to use their abilities in service to God and each other.
